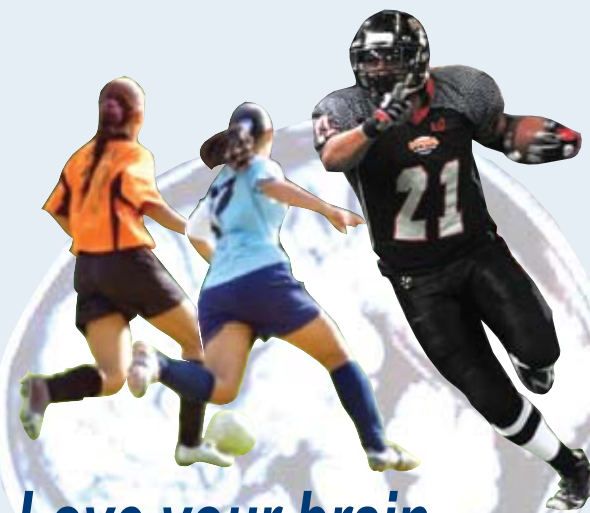

## What is CONCUSSION?

Concussion is the most common form of head injury for athletes. Often defined as a temporary alteration in mental state, it can be associated with immediate disorientation, amnesia, confusion, visual disturbance, headache, and sometimes loss of consciousness, as well as a host of other symptoms.



It is not necessary to lose consciousness, nor to actually hit your head to sustain a concussion. When symptoms such as headache, fatigue, irritability, and poor attention and/or concentration persist, the athlete may be suffering from a Post-Concussion Syndrome.



The cumulative effects of repeated concussion can result in intellectual, cognitive and emotional changes. Also, we know that **YOUTH ARE MORE VULNERABLE TO THE EFFECTS OF CONCUSSION.**

Help prevent and manage the lasting effects of concussion with pre-season baseline testing and post concussion follow up.
